No music experience of any kind is necessary, though if you have it, we’ll put it to use.

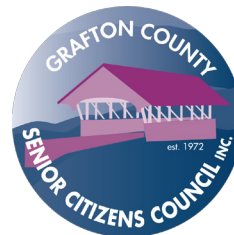
